Flu Shot Follow-up for LVMPDEHW Trust Participants

There have been many inquiries regarding another Flu Shot Clinic. It doesn't appear that we will be able to hold another clinic for flu shots at this time. Nevertheless, please remember that the Plan does not charge a co-pay for flu vaccines. A couple of good options if you want you and your family to get vaccinated is to take advantage of the **Minute Clinic in the CVS pharmacies** and the **Take Care Clinics in the Walgreens pharmacies**. These clinics will bill UMR directly and you won't have to hassle with a reimbursement. If you go to your doctor for a flu vaccine, it is likely that you will still have to pay your co-pay...so take advantage of the convenience of the mentioned clinics. The participating pharmacies with clinics are located at:

CVS Pharmacies – Ann & Decatur, Eastern & Horizon Ridge, Warm Springs and Durango, DI & Buffalo, Warm Springs & Spencer, 3758 Las Vegas Boulevard South

Walgreens Pharmacies – 1701 N. Green Valley Pky (Henderson), 9415 W. Desert Inn, 8500 W. Cheyenne, 7599 W. Lake Mead Blvd., 6865 W. Tropicana, 2389 E. Windmill Ln., 3480 S. Jones Blvd., 4905 W. Tropicana, 4895 Boulder Hwy., 3765 Las Vegas Blvd. S., 3339 S. Las Vegas Blvd, 2280 Las Vegas Blvd. (NLV), 1445 W. Craig Rd. (NLV), 4771 W. Craig Rd. (NLV). Other Walgreens Pharmacies that don't house a clinic will give flu shots, but they are not set up for billing. If you get a flu shot at a non-clinic location, you will have an out-of-pocket expense that you will have to submit for reimbursement.
